

COOKIE POLICY

Applicable from 5 August 2026

1 WHAT IS A COOKIE?

- 1.1 A cookie is a small data file that is stored on your computer, tablet, or smartphone when you visit a website. It is used to store information about your visit and improve your browsing experience.
- 1.2 Cookies are not programs and cannot contain or transmit harmful software or viruses. Furthermore, they cannot collect any information from your device, including personal data such as your name, address, or account details.

2 PROCESSING OF PERSONAL DATA BY USING COOKIES

- 2.1 This website uses cookies which may lead to the processing of personal data. Therefore, we recommend that you read our [Privacy Policy](#), which – among other things – describes our processing activities and your rights as a data subject.

3 THE WEBSITE'S USE OF COOKIES

- 3.1 Cookies are essential for the seamless operation of our website. They allow us to analyse your interaction with the site, facilitating ongoing enhancements tailored to your professional interests and requirements. Generally, cookies support our services by delivering content that is most pertinent to you. They play a key role in maintaining the website's efficiency, recalling your language preferences, and personalising our advertisements based on your cookie preferences.
- 3.2 Cookies on this website are set by .legal A/S and selected third parties (third-party cookies).

Two types of cookies are placed:

- Session cookies, which are stored on your device until you close your browser.
- Persistent cookies that are stored on your device for a longer period of time. When you return to the website, the cookie is automatically renewed.

- 3.3 Prior to your consent, we set the following necessary cookies in your browser, which do not contain personal data. These are: __cf_bm, __Cfruid and __Secure-ENID.

Besides these cookies, we do not set cookies without your consent.

__cf_bm is a necessary cookie that identifies and limits automated traffic, to protect the website from bots. This cookie expires after 30 minutes of continuous inactivity. The cookie is generated independently by Cloudflare and does not correspond to a user ID or other identifiers in your web application.

__cfuid is needed to manage incoming traffic and to get a better overview of the type of incoming traffic to avoid bots.

__Secure-ENID is a third-party cookie set by Google in connection with its search engine functionality. This cookie may be placed in the user's browser prior to accessing our website and is neither generated, controlled, nor influenced by us. Its presence on our website is therefore incidental to the user's prior interaction with Google's services.

- 3.4 You can manage your cookie preferences at any time by clicking on the cookie icon in the lower left corner of the website. The consent banner allows you to accept or reject the different categories of cookies used on the website — namely Necessary, Preferences, Statistics, and Marketing.

4 ANALYTICS WITHOUT COOKIES

- 4.1 For website analytics, we use Piwik PRO Analytics Suite. Piwik PRO is configured in cookieless mode, meaning it does not place cookies or store identifiers on your device.
- 4.2 The analytics provide us with aggregated insights into how the website is used, such as which pages are visited and the time spent on the site. To the extent that any personal data is processed in this connection, the processing takes place in accordance with our [Privacy Policy](#).

5 HOW LONG ARE COOKIES SAVED?

- 5.1 How long cookies are saved on your device can vary. The time when they are scheduled to expire is calculated from the last date you visited the website. When cookies expire, they are automatically deleted.

6 THIS IS HOW YOU CAN REJECT OR DELETE YOUR COOKIES

- 6.1 You can always reject cookies on your computer, tablet or phone by changing your browser settings. Where these settings can be found depends on the type of browser you are using. If you do change

the settings, please be aware that there will be some functions and services that you cannot use because they rely on the website being able to remember the choices you have made.

7 DELETING COOKIES

7.1 You can object to the use of cookies at any time. You can do this by changing your browser settings accordingly. Guidelines can be found here:
